1. SUBJECT:

Airplanes Z 142C, production Nos. 0542-0550 Airplanes Z 242L, production No. 0540, 0541,

0651-0657.

2. REASON:

In the above mentioned airplanes were installed the draining valves of the fuel tanks the springs of which have deficient surface finish.

3. MEASURES:

Replace valves by the new ones; the original ones to be returned to the producer.

4. MEASURES SHALL BE PERFORMED: During the next 500 hour check-up; at the latest toward the end of the year 1993.

- 5. SHALL BE PERFORMED BY: The user.
- 6. EXPENCES SHALL BE COVERED: The new parts pays the producer.
- 7. NECESSARY MATERIAL: The producer supplies the valves C 142.7214-02.00 with the bulletin. For the plane Z 142C - 5 pcs, for the plane Z 242L - 2 pcs - see enclosure.
- 8. PROCEDURE:

In planes indicated in the appendix unlock and screw in the new valves, which are marked near the hexagon's periphery by a visible centre punch, tighten and secure by a binding wire. The original valves send to the address: ZLIN AIRCRAFT a.s., 765 81 Otrokovice, Czech republic

- 9. THE BULLETIN IS EFFECTIVE SINCE THE DATE OF APPROVAL BY CIVIL AVIATION INSPECTORATE.
- 10. SUPPLEMENTS: Drawing of the replaced valve's positions on planes.
